All this sits alongside challenging calls to **Speak Truth to Power** and **Wait Without Hope** during an Advent exhibition.


A book group on Brian McLaren's **Great Spiritual Migration** may bridge the gap between these. Paintings and music will also inspire our journeys inward and outward!
